Getting or spreading Covid 19 whilst dancing	Callers and dance participants	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> No more that 30 dancers in accordance with government guidelines Dancers should wash or sanitise hands before the dancing starts Dancers should only dance with members of their household, support bubble or singly Social distancing should be maintained from other dancers and members of the public (2m if possible or minimum of 1m if not) Advise dancers not to attend if they have symptoms of Covid 19 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Participants should inform Chair of their intention to attend prior to the event Advise all participants of the rules by email or website Dance on the tarmac area in front of Kelham Hall to ensure plenty of room to maintain social distance Organisers to have hand sanitiser in case someone forgets theirs
A dancer may develop Covid 19 symptoms after the dance	Callers and dance participants	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Take names and up to date contact details of all dancers and keep for at least 21 days Advise dancers that this information might be shared for NHS Test and Trace purposes Advise dancers that they must inform The Chair or a member of the committee if they develop Covid 19 symptoms after the event 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Advise all participants of the rules by email or website
Members of the public may wish to join in with the dances	Callers, dance participants Members of the public	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Take their name and contact details for the record Remind them of the rules about maintaining social distance 	<ul style="list-style-type: none">

Dancers may be socialising before, during and after the dancing	Dance participants	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • There should be no more than 6 people together in a group maintaining 2m social distance from anyone not in their household or social bubble • Dancers should remain in the same group for the duration of the event and not swap groups or mingle with other groups • Hands should be washed or sanitised after touching tables and benches 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Advise all participants of the rules by email or website
Using the toilet facilities which are open to the public	Dance participants	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Advise dancers that extra hygiene care should be taken after using the public toilets 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Advise dancers that they may wish to bring their own hand towel as there is only a hot air dryer in the toilets
Dancer may require some form of assistance if for example they fall or become ill	Dance participant	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Advise dancers to have a face covering with them in case they need to provide assistance to someone outside their household 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Advise all participants of the rules by email or website
