## **Covid 19 guidance – Kelham Hall dancing**

This guidance should be reviewed before each event at Kelham Hall . If any dancers have safety concerns/suggestions please contact The Chair or member of the committee.

Current government guidelines must be observed at all times.

### ***What all dancers need to do***

1. Inform Helen (the Chair) of your intention to attend to ensure that maximum of 30 attendees is not exceeded.
2. Stay at home if you feel unwell and have symptoms of Covid 19.
3. When at Kelham Hall, wash or sanitise your hands before dancing and after touching potentially contaminated surfaces such as tables and benches
4. Dance only with members of your household or support bubble and maintain 2m distance from other dancers and the caller.
5. Remember to keep to a maximum of 6 people when socialising on the lawn area. Remain in the same group for the duration of the event and do not swap groups or mingle with other groups.
6. You must inform Helen or a member of the committee if you develop symptoms of or are diagnosed with Covid 19 after the event.

### ***General information***

1. Your contact details will be kept securely for at least 21 days after the event and this information might be shared for NHS Test and Trace purposes.
2. The public toilets are open and used by campers as well as members of the public. Be extra vigilant about hygiene when using them and wear a face covering if you deem it necessary. There is only a hot air hand dryer so you may wish to bring your own hand towel or paper towels for drying your hands.
3. it is advisable to have a face covering with you just in case a situation arises where you may be in closer contact with someone outside your household. E.g. Needing to provide assistance to someone else.
